### Novel Therapeutic Interventions for Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)

Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) previously known as Pervasive Developmental Disorders (PDD) is a neurodevelopmental disorder that begins early in childhood and lasts throughout a person's life. They are group of disorders characterized by delays in the development of socialization and communication skills and the presence of repetitive behaviors or circumscribed interests. They include Autism, Asperger's Syndrome, Childhood Disintegrative Disorder, and Rett's Syndrome. There is no known cure for ASD. Medications are used to address specific behavioral problems, early intervention including appropriate and specialized educational programs and support services plays a critical role in improving the outcome

### Advances in understanding addiction treatment and recovery

Substance use disorder (SUD) - commonly referred to as addiction - is a medical illness with altered behavioral, cognitive, physical, neurobiological, and affective functions associated with compulsive and repeated use of addictive substance(s), whether legal or illegal

Addiction is commonly associated with substance abuse, but behavioral addictions like internet or sex addiction are just as serious. Addiction is when a person is unable to consistently abstain from a behavior or substance. This is typically at the cost of their mental and physical health

Behavioral addictions are as serious as substance addictions. Both types result in dependency and have the same or similar negative consequences. Understanding the size and the different perspective of addiction problem as well as the medical and psychiatric comorbidities will help in minimize the addiction epidemic in our country
